Kinds of Sentences

Sentences end in punctuation marks. Telling sentences end in periods. Asking questions end in question marks. Exclamation marks end with sentences to show emotion.

Periods, question marks, and exclamation marks are called punctuation marks.

Commas in a Series

The comma is a punctuation mark. It is used with a list of 3 or more things.

Examples: The bear, monkey, and elephant live in the zoo. (There are 3 animals: bear, monkey, and elephant.)

I went shopping to buy a pencil, paper, glue, and a pair of scissors for school. (There are 4 things: a pencil, paper, glue, and a pair of scissors.)

The cookie recipe calls for flour, sugar, milk, eggs, and chocolate chips. (There are 5 things: flour, sugar, milk, eggs, and chocolate chips.)
